

OPERATION BEAT FURMAN ORDER 1-1

1. Situation. The Citadel plays Furman on 10 Sept at 1800. This is also Military Appreciation Day.

2. Mission. The SCCC executes a pep rally on 10 Sept from 0830 to 1200 on Summerall Field in order to support the team, display school spirit, and have fun. The Corps Competition (“Field Day”) and Military Appreciation Day activities will be combined with the pep rally schedule.

3. Execution.

a. Commander’s Intent. The desired end state is victory on Saturday. In order to achieve that end state the SCCC must show its support for the football team and its esprit de corps as a unit. The football team must show its appreciation of the SCCC and express the value it places on SCCC support. Additionally, by combining this event with Military Appreciation Day we join with community partners to honor those who have and are serving.

b. Concept of Operations. The concept is to create a festive pre-game atmosphere with a combination of military, social, and sports events. Phase I is set up and runs from 0730-0830. Phase II is corps activities and games that runs from 0830-1100. Phase III is the Palmetto Warrior Connection (PWC) vs. cadets in flag football and runs from 1100-1200 while selected other Phase II activities also continue. Phase IV is clean up and release. Lunch will be speed line in the mess hall per the training schedule. Operations Overlay is at Annex A.

c. Scheme of Maneuver. During Phase I, each battalion will occupy and establish a battalion assembly area. The Regimental Activities Officer will coordinate the setup of the DJ, Bubble Soccer, Obstacle Course, Pie Tossing, Dunking Booth, cornhole and CADIC. During Phase II, cadets will participate in or watch Pep Rally and Corps Competition activities and the DJ will play music. During Phase III, activity on the football field will transition from Corps Competition games to the cadets v. Palmetto Warriors game. Phase II activities will continue elsewhere. During Phase IV, Regimental Supply will supervise clean up.

d. Tasks to Subordinate Units

i. Commandant

- a) Allocate a budget of \$1,000 (Bubble Soccer, Obstacle Course, Pie Tossing, Paladin Costume and Dunking Booth) and act as approval authority for funding requests.
- b) Brief the President of the event.

ii. Office of Cadet Activities.

- a) Overall responsible for the event.

- b) Coordinate for DJ support and have him/her submit his invoice to Chief McIntyre.
- c) Supervise Cadet Activities and Supply cadet chain of command performance of their duties.
- d) Coordinate for Brigadier and photography support.
- e) Rent Bubble Soccer, Dunking Booth, Obstacle Course, have Pie Tossing Booth built, but do not spend more than \$1000 on them without AC for Leadership Programs approval. Submit invoices to Chief McIntyre.
- f) Coordinate with Mr. Bouton or other Deas Hall rep for cornholes and support for the cadets v. Palmetto Warriors game.
- g) Coordinate with Cheerleader Coach to have cheerleaders and Spike at the event; also have a cheerleader to wear the “Paladin” costume for the tug of war competition.
- h) Contact Facilities and Engineering to set up an 8 x 8 tent for the DJ, hang banner “BEAT FURMAN” in the mess hall week of event, have water hose available to fill dunking booth, mark sprinklers on parade field, cut off sprinkler system for that morning and make sure water is on at the fire hydrant for dunking booth.
- i) Coordinate with Athletic Dept. (Danielle Dillahey and Taylor Wall) about the flag football game, PWC vs. cadets.
- j) Prepare a continuity book and AAR and submit to the Assistant Commandant for Leadership Programs.
- k) Brief event at the department meeting.
- l) Coordinate with LTC Keith Brace (advisor for Summerall Guards) about being in charge of the Dunking Booth and authorize it as a fund raiser.
- m) Develop a detailed backward planning sequence and schedule IPRs with the Assistant Commandant for Leadership Programs.
- n) Organize and conduct a rehearsal on 30 August at 1140 on Summerall Field.
- o) Coordinate with the Assistant Commandant for Operations and Training for any space management and other synchronization needs between the Pep Rally and the Corps Competition.

iii. Assistant Commandant for Operations and Training.

- a) Put event on training schedule.
- b) Coordinate for the use of Summerall Field.
- c) Advise Public Safety of the event.
- d) Be responsible for the Corps of Competition and coordinate space management and other issues with the Director, Cadet Activities.

iv. Regimental Commander

- a) Encourage maximum participation
- b) Develop a risk management plan and submit to the Assistant Commandant for Operations and Training for approval.
- c) Develop and issue orders and instructions to the SCCC as required.
- d) Provide necessary command and control during the event.

- e) Supervise tasks assigned to the Regimental Staff.
- v. Cadet Activities Officer
 - a) Assign one bn activities officer to be responsible for each of the following:
 - 1) Pie Tossing and liaison with Summerall Guards for dunking booth and CADIC for beer goggles station.
 - 2) Bubble Soccer
 - 3) Spike v. Paladin Tug-of-War and cadets v. Palmetto Warriors game
 - 4) Obstacle Course
 - 5) Cornholes and DJ operations
- vi. Cheerleading Captain
 - a) Provide one cadet to be the “Paladin” character in the Tug-of-War
 - b) Coordinate for Spike to be in the Tug-of-War
 - c) Provide cheering support for Spike in the Tug-of-War
- vii. Battalion TACs
 - a) Provide at least one TAC to cover the event for the battalion.
- viii. Director, CADIC
 - a) Set up beer goggles and other displays/events.
 - b) If possible, provide funding through NCAA grant.
- ix. Coordinating Instructions
 - a) Uniform is PTs.

4. Sustainment.

- a. Class I. Breakfast and lunch are in the mess hall per the training schedule.

5. Command and Control.

- a. Mrs. Ward is overall in charge of this event. The Regt Commander, Regimental XO, Regimental Athletics Officer, and Regimental Cadet Activities Officer will report to her for further instructions.
